- Research the different planets and create a model (either 3D or 2D) representing our solar system.
- Design a timeline explaining the history of the space race.
- Listen to different pieces of jazz music and create a piece of work on the history of the pieces and their singers/composers including an appraisal of what you have listen to.

These are just a few ideas, if you would like to complete something else based on your school topics, please feel free to do so. Be as creative as you like and please take pride in your work!
