## Digital Progression

We are yet again increasing our technology in school and have 1-1 I-pads in Years 4, 5 and 6 next year. The teachers are continually looking for ways to make pupil learning more engaging and meaningful through the use of technology. Mrs Mandy Clark is our digital link governor and is giving great support to the school through feedback about our website and discussions about the digital progression in school.

#### PTFA

The Parents, Teachers and Friends association helps to organise fundraising events for the school. Our next meeting is on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September 6.15pm in school. There is no commitment to be part of a committee or to help out in any specific way. We would love to see more parents there to support the lovely events that we have planned for the year, so please do come along! £163 was raised from the family barbecue. The majority of the funds raised last year have gone on replenishing reading books and there will be many new books for the children to use in the new school year.

#### Office Staff

We have a new lady in the senior admin position in the office - Miss Wilson and a new office manager starting in three weeks. Whilst new staff are getting used to their roles and we are also short of staff, please have patience and only contact the office if urgent. ## Tesco Funding

Thank you to everyone who voted for us at Tesco. We have been awarded £500 to upgrade the reading corners in classrooms.

On average, pupils who regularly read for pleasure go onto achieve the highest attainments at secondary school. We are therefore having a strong focus on this aspect of reading this year. If you have any ideas about how we can further encourage our pupils with reading, please let us know.

## School Safe Haven Parking

We did apply to be part of this scheme through Derby City Council, but unfortunately were not successful. Being part of the scheme would have meant that an area outside school would become pedestrian only for certain times in the school day. However, we could still achieve much greater levels of safety if **no-one parked on the cul-de-sac outside school**. Parking here is already not allowed during the school day but the signage is small. Please consider our neighbours and the safety of the school community and consider carefully where you park.

#### Instrument Lessons

There are opportunities for children to learn the guitar, piano, violin, saxophone, clarinet and flute in school through the peripatetic teachers. Rocksteady is also in school, where children learn to play the keyboard, drums, electric guitar, bass and to sing as part of the band. There is a subsidy for lessons if your child is eligible for pupil premium funding. Please get in touch with the school office if you are interested.

#### School Unform

Please ensure that pupils are wearing the correct uniform. Last year, there was a distinct lack of uniformity on PE days. We have therefore purchased spare kit and if pupils are not in the correct uniform, they will be asked to change into the Ravensdale kit for the day.

The only jewellery allowed are stud earrings, watches (not Smart watches) and religious items that are a key expectation of that religion. All must be removed or covered up for PE and it is the responsibility of the parent to ensure that this happens eg sending a sweat band that can cover a bangle, or tape to cover earrings. Children must be able to organise this for themselves in school.

#### Mobile Phones

Year 6 children are only allowed to bring a mobile phone into school if they live outside of the typical catchment area for Ravensdale (ie the child has to cross Station Road or Uttoxeter Road or lives in Mackworth). There also needs to be a legitimate reason why the child needs to bring the phone to school. Parents and pupils must sign a contract before a phone can be brought into school.
