#### Dear parents and carers

As I mentioned in the last newsletter, we are very proud to be able to offer 4 residential visits over the year. Our enrichment offer, is something that we are working hard to improve, as a wide breadth of experience can help not only with life skills, but also with reading, as pupils expand their knowledge about the world. They are also lots of fun!

Our new assistant head teacher, Mrs Staley-West, is leading on enrichment for Ravensdale and we are developing a new tab on the website, so you will be able to see all that is on offer across the school.

We currently have a sports club running every afternoon after school and the take up for these has been very high.

Lunchtime clubs are also very popular and easy for pupils to access. The following clubs are available this term: art (yr6), girls' football (Yr4), Rounders (Yr5 and 6), skipping (Yr 3 and 4), book club (Yr3) and drawing club (Yr3). At lunchtime, our sport coach, Mr Saratt, organises games such as football, dodgeball and cricket on the playground. All great fun!

We are also looking to give pupils opportunities in leadership. Miss Akhtar runs the school council which meets once per half term. Mrs Cannon runs the Eco-Council which meets weekly where possible and is focused on improving the school grounds, as well as recycling and our use of energy in school. Mrs Wright runs I-Vengers council looking at improving e-safety across the school. Pupils had to provide a written application to be part of this council. Some children will soon be trained as mini-leaders to lead games on the playground.

#### **RSE**

During the summer term, we teach relationships and sex education. This is done in an age appropriate way for each year group and we follow the Christopher Winter's scheme. Details of what is covered are on our website. however, we always offer a meeting for parents so that you can understand more about what is taught in each year group and ask any questions. The meetings are led by our PSHE lead, Mrs Brown. This year the meetings are at 9.00am and 6pm on Wednesday 17th May. Parents are only permitted to withdraw pupils from the reproduction element of our curriculum which is one lesson in Year 6.

#### Litter

We seem to have an increasing amount of litter on the school grounds. Most of this is sweet wrappers. As children do not have sweets in school, some of this may be coming from children at the end of the school day. Please could you help us to keep the school tidy by taking any litter home with you.

#### Menstruation

As girls often start a period in school, we have developed a school protocol around menstruation. This protocol can be found under the policies tab on our website and the link is here

We do have some girls who are starting their periods in Year 4 and this can be worrying for them if they do not know what is happening. We would suggest that you have a conversation with your daughters around this age about periods so that it does not come as a shock. We do not cover this until they are older in school.

## Keeping your Children Safe

There are new video games coming out all the time and it can be difficult to know which ones are appropriate for your child. PEGI helps parents to make informed decisions when buying video games.

PEGI provides age classifications for video games in 38 European countries. The age rating confirms that the game content is appropriate for players of certain age. PEGI considers the age suitability of a game, not the level of difficulty.

Please keep in mind that many video games contain very strong negative images - once seen these cannot easily be forgotten.

## Local Elections - photo ID needed

Derby will be going to the polls again for local elections on Thursday 4 May, and this year there are several changes for residents to be aware of.

This will be the first time that voters will be legally required to bring photo ID to vote. This is a new requirement, introduced by the UK Government's Elections Act which was passed last year and comes into effect for the first time this May.

Accepted forms of ID include certain passports, driving licenses and some concessionary travel passes, such as an older person's bus pass. Voters will also be able to use expired eligible ID, if they are still recognisable in their photo.

Most people will already have an accepted form of photo ID, but if not, they can apply for a Voter Authority Certificate online. More information about voter ID can be found at <a href="https://www.derby.gov.uk/voterid">www.derby.gov.uk/voterid</a>.

This will also be the first whole Council election in the city in recent memory. Every seat on the council is up for election and the successful candidates will remain in power for four years. With that in mind, it's important that as many residents as possible are ready to take part by registering to vote and having their photo ID ready before polling day.

#### Coronation Celebration

On Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May we will be celebrating the Coronation. Children are invited to come to school dressed in red, white and blue and we will be holding a special assembly. At 11am, the whole school will be parading out of school, down Derwent Avenue and back into school. Children are invited to bring in any 'noise makers' such as small drums, kazoos, triangles etc. We do have some in school to ensure that all children have something, but anything from home would be appreciated.
