A huge well done to our Year 6 pupils for coping so very well with some challenging SATs tests. The year 6 teachers had prepared the children extremely well, so that they all knew what to expect. Two weeks previously, they had taken part in a Mock Sats Week, so that they knew exactly which room they would be in, with which teacher and at what time.

Staff ensure that the children still receive a very balanced curriculum in Year 6, whilst ensuring that they are prepared both academically and emotionally for the tests. In other year groups, the children all complete NTS tests on a termly basis, which are very similar to SATS, so the children become very familiar with the process.
