Create your own Rangoli pattern and remember to make them bright and bold.



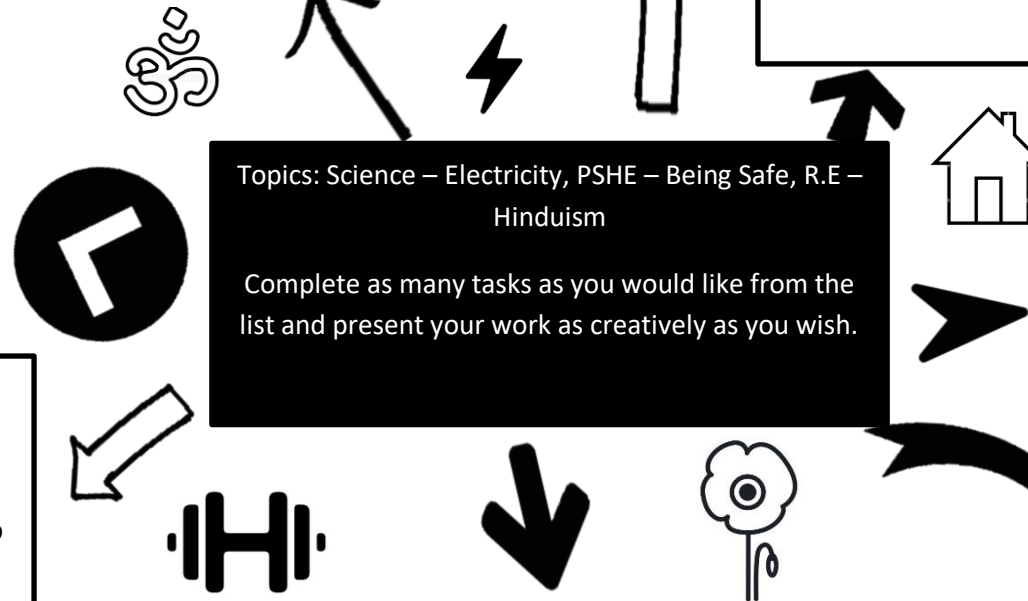
Staying Safe Online
